Dr. Stuart Baron of Springfield, 73, hospital chief of family practice

Published in the Star-Ledger on 1/16/2005.

A service for Dr. Stuart Baron, 73, of Springfield will be at 11:30 a.m. today in the Menorah Chapels at Millburn, 2950 Vauxhall Rd., Union.

Dr. Baron, who died Friday in Overlook Hospital, Summit, was a family practitioner with offices in Mountainside, and later in Springfield, for 40 years before retiring in 1999.

He served on the medical staff of Overlook Hospital, Summit, Saint Barnabas Medical Center, Livingston, and Union Hospital. At Overlook Hospital, he was the first doctor to be elected to two terms as chief of family practice and also served two terms as vice chief of family practice.

Additionally, he served as the doctor for the Mountainside Police

Department, the Mountainside Fire Department and the Pop Warner Football squads.

Dr. Baron graduated from Tulane University with a bachelors degree and from Kansas City College of Osteopathy and Surgery with a medical degree.

He was a member of the Model A Ford Club of New Jersey, the Model A Ford Club of America, a member of the Union and Mercer Model Air Plane clubs.

Dr. Baron was also a life-member of the National Rifle Association and the Kiwanis Club of Mountainside, and was a member of the Sigma Sigma Phi, a national osteopathic fraternity.

Born in Brooklyn, N.Y., he lived in Mountainside for many years before moving to Springfield 29 years ago.

Surviving are Sandra, his wife of 41 years, and sons, Jonathan and Gregory.
