Jack Martin's Latest Model "A"



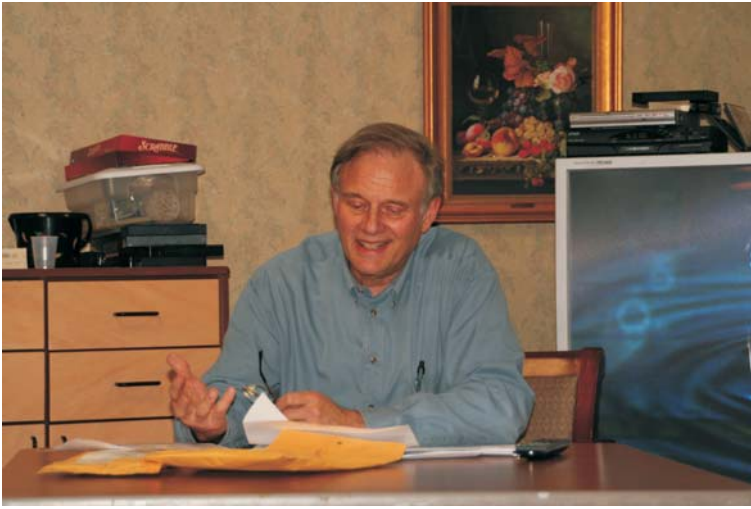

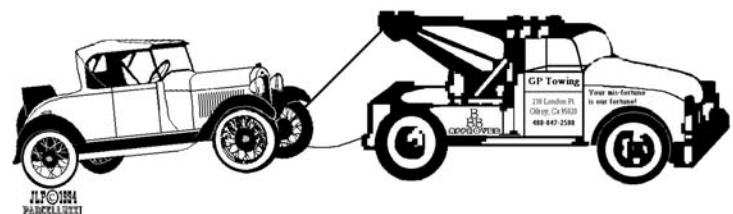
